

Setting up your Organisational account

This document contains step-by-step instructions on how to set up your GIS for Schools account.

Activation email



This section explains the contents of the activation email:

- 1. Once your request for a GIS for schools bundle has been processed by Esri Australia, you will receive an instructional email as seen to the right.
- 2. The email contains instructions you will need to follow in order to successfully set up your school's account.
- 3. Follow each of the three steps as set out in the email. Detailed explanations of each of these steps exist as you progress through this guide.

We are excited to have you implement ArcGIS software in your classroom!

We are very proud to announce that we have extended the GIS for Schools software giveaway. As well as ArcGIS Online, your school can now access ArcGIS Pro if you wish to go further with GIS.

This email contains important instructions about creating an Esri account and activating your subscription. Please note that the subscription must be activated by the person who will be the administrator for the ArcGIS Online subscription. If that is not you, please forward this email to the appropriate person.

STEP 1: CREATE A NEW ARCGIS ONLINE ACCOUNT

To begin creating a new ArcGIS Online account, click on the link below: https://www.arcgis.com/home/activate.html?activationcode=5cfb916ef0371 If you cannot click on the link above, please copy the URL into your browser window.

Choose 'By creating a new account' and work through the steps.

STEP 2: ACTIVATE YOUR ARCGIS ONLINE SUBSCRIPTION

Once you have created a new account, you will be prompted to choose a user type. Select GIS Professional Advanced and click Activate.

You will then be required to fill out several fields pertaining to the setting up of your organisation's ArcGIS Online subscription. It is advised you enter details relevant to the school you are setting the account up for.

After agreeing to the Terms of Use, select Save and Continue to complete the activation process.

STEP 3: LINK YOUR ORGANISATION'S ACCOUNT WITH MY ESRI TO ACCESS LICENCING AND DOWNLOADS

An Esri Account is required to access My Esri, which is where you can download additional software – such as ArcGIS Pro – and manage your licence.

In order to access these downloads and manage your licence, you must first link your Esri Account to your organisation. Click the embedded token link below to begin this process:

- 4. Once you've completed the three steps, your school account is ready to go.
- 5. The email contains other important information such as a Subscription ID and a Customer number.

It also contains additional information about the product that you've received.

It is recommended that you save this email appropriately in case you need to reference these details in the future.

6. The end of the email contains links and contact information for further guidance.

Step 1: Create a new ArcGIS Online account

This section takes you through Step 1 of the activation email.


1. After reading the instructions for Step 1 in the email, click on the activation url link provided. Alternatively, copy and paste the url link into a browser window. Note: this activation link is unique to your school.

STEP 1: CREATE A NEW ARCGIS ONLINE ACCOUNT

To begin creating a new ArcGIS Online account, click on the link below: https://www.arcqis.com/home/activate.html?activationcode=5cfb916ef0371b2fqblb If you cannot click on the link above, please copy the URL into your browser window.

Choose 'By creating a new account' and work through the steps.

2. This will take you to ArcGIS Online and will present you with two options. Choose the first option, By creating a new account, and click Next. Note: As you are setting this account up for your school, always choose this option. Do not choose the second option even if you do have an existing ArcGIS Public Account.






Step 2: Activate your ArcGIS Online Subscription

This section takes you through Step 2 of the activation email.

1. After choosing **By creating a new account** and clicking **Next** (as seen in the previous step), you will be required to create your account. Complete each field, following the guidelines and prompts that appear next to each field.



2. Review the Terms of Use and Privacy Policy. Check the checkboxes if you are happy to process. Click **Create My Account**.




3. As per the email instructions for Step 2, Choose GIS Professional Advanced and click Activate.






4. Finish setting up your school's account by completing the fields that appear on the webpage.



5. Click **Save and Continue** once you have completed all of the fields.


SAVE AND CONTINUE

Upon logging in for the first time you will be presented with a Home page with the following tabs:





Click on 'Organization'. An overview of your account is displayed. This is a place where you can gain a quick snapshot of your organisation's licencing details, members, credits available, and recent activity.



Step 3: Link your organisation's account with My Esri to access licencing and downloads

This section takes you through Step 3 of the activation email.

1. Return to the email and read through Step 3's instructions. Click on the embedded token link to begin the process of linking your newly created ArcGIS Online account to My Esri.


